### PWB Abilene Scholarship Application Period Now Open for FALL 2024 Enrollment!

**POSTMARK DEADLINE: Friday, April 5, 2024**

This scholarship fund encourages individuals to further their education and training in *housing industry related programs*. **Scholarships to be awarded for FALL 2024**; application period now open for qualified applicants.

\*Those receiving PWB awards in the Fall of 2023 are not eligible for this scholarship cycle\*

Applicants must be high school seniors with plans to enroll OR students currently enrolled at an **accredited two-year or four-year college or university, trade, or vocational program** and pursuing an education/certification in a housing-related course of study (for examples of applicable industry careers and/or fields please see the application page).

**REQUIREMENTS FOR A FULL AND VALID SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION SUBMISSION:** Applicant must submit *ALL* required documentation by the posted deadline. If all requested items are not included and/or minimum requirements are not met, the application will not be eligible for review by the PWB Scholarship Committee.

- 1) Complete and thorough **Scholarship Application Questionnaire** (see attached)
- 2) **Essay** (minimum 200 words) outlining goals and reason for pursuing an education in your desired field
- 3) Most recent school **transcript** to be submitted with application
- 4) **Recommendation letter** from educator, school administrator, or academic counselor
- 5) **Proof of acceptance/enrollment** in higher education plan required; *scholarship funds will be made payable directly to the institution of higher learning on behalf of the scholarship recipient*

*\*Please note that previous recipients are not eligible to receive this award in successive years\**
