If doing a talent performance that requires music, 1 copy on a CD or flash drive is due the **day of talent rehearsal** in **LAURA GILBERT'S POSSESSION**. This CD or flash drive should **ONLY** contain the music used for the performance, **NOTHING ELSE!** (Make sure it is the only song). If singing, no vocals should be in the song other than backup vocals.

Each contestant is responsible for getting her own driver and vehicle to be used in the parade as well as 2 signs stating contestant's name and sponsor's name. (**Convertibles ONLY and your driver cannot be your boyfriend.**) Clothing needed for this year's pageant include an opening number outfit (to be announced at the tea), talent outfit, evening gown, and a casual wear outfit. (**If it takes pantyhose and heels, it's NOT casual wear & it's not a costume.**)

An introduction to your talent performance on a 3X5 index card needs to be turned in along with the CD or flash drive for Practice on the **day of talent rehearsal**. There will be an opening number speech that should include contestant name, contestant number, and sponsor's name. There will also be an evening gown speech **NO longer than 1 ½ minutes**, that should include the same information along with parent's name(s), your accomplishments and plans for the future (limit the number of people you thank).
