  - D. Represent community needs and values - what's important to the families regarding health based on CDC Whole Child Model:

    - 6. Health Services
    - 7. Counseling, Psychological/Social Services

- III. Recent Changes
  - A. 2020 - State Board of Education updated state health curriculum, added standards to TEKS that include age appropriate instruction on sexual and reproductive health in certain grades
  - B. 2021 - HB 1525, requires more public access to SHAC and increases the procedural requirements for school districts that offer human sexuality instruction.
- IV. What Jim Ned CISD needs now
  - A. Approximately 5-15 individuals (parents (must be majority), community members, students, administration) who will commit to serving on SHAC for 1-3 years, 4 meetings/year
