Jim Ned High School Prohibited Substances Policy

This policy is in place to discipline students who, on campus or in attendance at a school sponsored or related activity, use, possess, sale, or distribute prohibited substances or devices that do not fall under other mandatory Texas Education Code directives.

These substances or devices include, but are not limited to, tobacco, nicotine, vapes, juuls, e-cigarettes or any device that can deliver a prohibited substance.

- 1st Offense 3 days of ISS
- 2nd Offense 5 days of ISS
- 3rd Offense − 10 days of DAEP
- 4th Offense DAEP for remainder of semester or 20 days (whichever is greater)
