

White-McIntyre Academic Scholarship Application: 2023-2024 School Year

The purpose of this scholarship program is to recognize a high school graduating student with a one-time monetary award of not less than \$250.00 to help offset the cost of higher education. Applicants will be considered based on academic participation and achievement, good leadership and citizenship, and engagement in school/community service. Students must meet the graduation requirements of Jim Ned Consolidated Independent School District. Students who have accepted a 'full ride' from a college or university or trade school (either athletic, academic or any combination) are <u>not</u> eligible to apply.

This scholarship is being offered through the Dacus Foundation and will be awarded at the 2024 Jim Ned All Academic Banquet on the evening of <u>May 20th</u>, 2024. Award recipient may or may not be top of the class, but he\she will have shown such exceptional performance and achievement, participation, dedication, and community spirit during his\her overall school experience that it is deemed as deserving of this special recognition. While attendance is not mandatory it is highly encouraged to attend when receiving an award.

Qualification Criteria:

- 1.) Be presently a senior at JNCISD and have participated in approved academic programs
- 2.) Have had no school suspensions (in school or out of school)
- 3.) Submit a completed application, including cover letter, essay, verified Grade Point Average of 3.0 or above all four years and Recommendation letter from a school faculty member
