Weldon and Georgia Dacus Athletic Scholarship Application: 2024-2025 School Year

The purpose of this scholarship program is to recognize a high school graduating student athlete with a one-time monetary award of not less than \$250.00 to help offset the cost of higher education. Applicants will be considered based on athletic participation and achievement, good sportsmanship and citizenship, and engagement in school/community service. Students must meet the graduation requirements of Jim Ned Consolidated Independent School District. Students who have accepted a 'full ride' from a college or university or trade school (either athletic, academic or any combination) are <u>not</u> eligible to apply.

This scholarship is being offered through the Dacus Foundation. Award recipient may or may not be the team's best athlete, but he\she will have shown such exceptional enthusiasm, participation, dedication, and team spirit during his\her overall school experience that it is deemed as deserving of this special recognition.

Qualification Criteria:

- 1.) Be presently a senior at JNCISD and have participated in approved athletics program (at any time during your high school enrollment at JNCISD)
- 2.) Have had no athletic or school suspensions (in school or out of school)
- 3.) Submit 1) a completed application, including 2) a cover letter, 3) an essay, 4) a verified Grade Point Average of 2.5 or above all four years and 5) a Coach's Recommendation form
