4. Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
5. Must be a student whose parent, legal guardian or grandparent is a graduate of Jim Ned.
6. Preference will be given to those showing financial need.

Essays:

At the end of the application, you will be asked to submit an essay. In approximately 500 words name a Jim Ned Alumni that has had a positive influence in your life. Describe how that person has been a positive influence on you, the year they graduated Jim Ned and what programs/sports/extracurriculars that person participated in while attending Jim Ned High School. Your composition, grammar and presentation will be considered by the Alumni selection committee.

The deadline to submit your application and essay is **5:00 p.m., Friday, May 8, 2026**. Late submissions will not be considered.
